

GUIDE TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND'S IDENTIFICATION INFORMATION

Keeping track of your identity information can be a daunting task. Adding to the complexity is that individual campus departments require different login and password information to access their systems. To help you manage this process, we have compiled the *Guide to the University of Maryland's Identification Information*.

This guide is for your information only. Please do not use it to record your data as it could give others access to your personal information.

Student Identification (SID): ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ (9 digits - numeric)

(This is typically a social security number. If you do not have a social security number, or did not supply a social security number on your application, this may be a university assigned number.)

Personal Identification Number (PIN): ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ (6 digits - numeric)

(initially set to your 6-digit birth date MMDDYY format)

Used in conjunction with your SID, this can allow you access to some university systems.

University Identification (UID): ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ ___ (9 digits - numeric)

Directory ID: _____(text based - number of character will vary)

Password: _____

(Must have a high level of complexity - will include both numbers and letters)
